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Soar To Survive: A Diary of Treatment

Seven years ago, Mrs. TJ was diagnosed with breast cancer. She consulted with Dr. Ucar regarding treatment, and today she is cancer free. Following are a few highlights from her personal diary, documenting her journey through diagnosis and treatment.

- 1998 During a shower I detected a lump in my left breast.
- It was diagnosed as a 2 cm lump, and a mammogram confirmed the suspicion.
- A fine-needle aspiration proved that it was invasive cancer.
- I was told I would have to have my lymph nodes removed from my left armpit in order to accurately determine the stage of the cancer.

The decision I had to make was between:

- 1. Remove the breast lumps and nodes in the armpit followed by radiation, or
- 2. Remove the whole breast and nodes from the armpit and no radiation ...
